Wine Grapes that Grow well in North Texas

Black Spanish Grapes

Very vigorous, hardy, disease resistant, large cluster grapes perfect for making red wine. Thin skin, tough, dark purple grape with tender, juicy flesh. It is a small to medium, bluish black fruit. Heavily productive vines ripen in late in the season.



Blanc du Bois Grapes

Very vigorous, hardy, disease resistant, large cluster grapes perfect for making white wine. Large, white grapes ripen early in the season. Upright growth habit. When produced correctly this is an excellent white spicy wine that can be dry, semi-sweet, or sparkling. These grapes ripen mid-season.



Champanel Grapes

Very vigorous, hardy, disease resistant grapes perfect for making blush wine and champagne. The cluster is small with large, black seeded berries which are very acidic until fully ripe. These grapes ripen early in the season.
