'Anson Jones' !	Yellow	Shrub - Texas Pioneer Rose. Upright growth habit with creamy yellow blooms that vary in intensity.
'Archduke Charles' !	Crimson	China. Blooms darken from light pink to crimson. Repeat bloomer.
'Audubon'	Red	Texas Pioneer Rose. Big show of unique single flowers. Large vigorous bush.
'Autumn Damask' !	Pink	Damask. Amazingly fragrant flowers bloom spring and fall.
'Bayse's Purple' !	Purple	Shrub. Large single purple flowers and thorny stems.
'Buff Beauty' !	Apricot	Hybrid Musk. Nearly continuous bloomer with double blooms and a sweet scent.
'Cadenza'!	Red	Climber. Masses of bright blooms on stiff canes. Good cut flower. Grow as a shrub or peg.
'Caroline Hairston' !	Cream	Texas Pioneer Rose. Large semi-double blooms are held nicely above this large shrub.
'Cecile Brunner', Cl. !	Pink	Polyantha Climber. Clusters of flowers bloom on old wood.
'Clytemnestra'!	Apricot	Hybrid Musk. NRS Gold Medal 1914. Good as a climber or large shrub.
'Cole's Settlement'!	White	Texas Pioneer Rose. Large creamy single blooms. Orange Hips.
'Coral Beauty' !	Salmon	Polyantha. Clusters of small flowers on a compact shrub; excellent for borders and containers.
'Dame De Coeur' !	Crimson	Early Hybrid Tea. Large, double blooms darken with age. Excellent for cutting.
'Dublin Bay' !	Red	Climbing. Fragrant, rose can be trained as a climber or used as a large shrub.
'Englemen's Quest'!	Yellow	Texas Pioneer Rose. Large open blooms. Good in a border or a pot.
'F.J. Lindheimer'!	Yellow Orange	Shrub -Texas Pioneer Rose. Repeat bloomer, color changes as flowers mature.
'Felicia' !	Apricot	Hybrid Musk. Intense fragrance makes an outstanding cut flower.
'Ferdinand Pichard'	Pink	Hybrid Perpetual. Unique sweet, bourbon scented blooms. Bright green foliage.
'Forever Irene' !	Red	Texas Pioneer Rose. Fragrant, dark red rose fades to crimson. Good repeat bloomer.
'Gainesville Garnet'	Red	Found. Large blooms. Can be treated as a large shrub or trained as a small climber.
'Great Western'!	Red	Bourbon. Masses of maroon blooms on graceful canes. Strong bourbon scent. Good cut flower.
'Highway 290 Pink Buttons'!	Pink	Found Rose. Small rosy pink blossoms on a compact form.
'Kazanlik'!	Pink	Damask. Often used as the source for commercial rose oils. Dry for potpurri at home.
'Lady Pamela Carol' !	Yellow	Texas Pioneer Rose. Three inch blooms on a vigorous bush.
'Landmark Rose' !	Pink	Shrub -Texas Pioneer Rose. Flat, ruffled, soft pink blooms.
'Mae Dean' !	Pink	Texas Pioneer Rose. Fragrant, showy double blooms on long canes are perfect for cutting.
'Maggie' !	Violet	Shrub. A found rose with highly fragrant flowers all summer and some hips in the fall.
'Marie Van Houtte' !	Yellow & Pink	Tea. Fragrant blooms contrast nicely with the dark shiny foliage.
'Martha Gonzales' !	Scarlet	China. A found rose that is a continuous show of single petal blooms. Disease resistant.
'Mier Y Teran' !	Pink	Texas Pioneer Rose. Fragrant, large, double blooms grow on a vigorous shrub.
'Miss Lillian' !	Apricot	Shrub - Texas Pioneer Rose. Fragrant apricot-pink blend blooms. Almost thornless.
'Moroccan Rose' !	Pink	Found. Fragrant pink flowers bloom on long canes. Unique, fragrant rose.
'Nacogdoches' !	Yellow	Found. Eye-catching, bright yellow pointed blooms are great for cutting.
'Old Baylor'!	White	Texas Pioneer Rose. Vigorous shrub with abundance of single blooms.

Antique Roses

These Old Garden roses are naturally disease resistant, hardier and require less care than most other roses. Garden roses are generally very fragrant and adaptable to a variety of landscape situations. They have many classifications ranging from dwarfs to cluster blooms to climbers and everything in between.

David Austin English Roses

These roses bring the romance and charm of the roses of years past to your garden. Their blooms are packed with layers of petals, appealing fragrances and soft coloring.

Climbing Roses

Many of our modern rose climbers originated from hybrid teas that have a tendency to grow unusually long canes. Climbers can grow to a length of 18 to 20 feet and bloom as profusely as many hybrid teas. Unlike other types of roses, climbers are not pruned heavily each spring. They should be selectively pruned after the first flush of blooms.

Florascape Roses

These hardy spreading roses quickly cover large areas creating a carpet of low maintenance color ideal for slopes and rocky areas. Great in baskets for trailing color.

Floribunda Roses

This type of rose began as a cross between Polyantha and hybrid tea. The cross was such a success that an entire new call of rose was named. These shrubs reach 2 ½ to 3 ½ feet in height, with dense branching. They are free blooming with small blooms in large clusters.

Grandiflora Roses

Queen Elizabeth, when it was introduced in 1955, was clearly an extraordinary rose. However, it did not fit any of the already existing classifications. It was, therefore, given the distinction of naming a rose category for it. This type usually ranges from 4 ½ feet upward with long stems sometimes supporting several blooms, but slightly smaller than hybrid tea. Most Grandiflora shrubs support a heavy compliment of blooms throughout the growing season and are an excellent source of flowers.

Hybrid Tea Roses

This is the best type for cut flowers since each stem has only one bloom. Bushes grow 3 ½ to 4 ½ feet tall and get bigger in ideal conditions. The Hybrid Tea is the most popular type of rose sold in America.

Miniature Roses

These roses are small in stature but are prolific bloomers. They generally do not exceed 2 feet tall and bloom continuously with small flowers. They are extremely low maintenance and are great for containers.

Shrub/Hedge Roses

These roses are easy-care, versatile and fragrant. They adapt well to many soils and temperatures. They have colorful hips throughout winter.

Tree Roses

The tree rose is made from three different rose shrubs-one from the root, stalk and blooming variety. This form of rose usually comes in three sizes 18", 24" and 36". We also offer a 2fer Tree Rose, this is a rose standard with two varieties on one plant.
