Evergreen Wisteria <i>Millettia reticulata</i>	Woody semi-evergreen twining vine. Deep wine, pea shaped flowers. Zones 8-10.
<b>Annual</b>	
Butterfly Pea <i>Clitoria ternatea</i>	Modest vine reaching 8-10 feet. Electric blue flowers from spring to summer followed by pea-like pods.
Morning Glory <i>Ipomoea purpurea</i>	Vigorous vine rapidly growing to 15-30 feet. Blue or pink flowers 3"-5" across.
Cypress Vine 'Cardinalis' <i>Ipomoea quamoclit</i>	Gorgeous, fern-like foliage with beautiful, red 1" tubular flowers. Blooms in profusion late summer through fall. Hummingbirds love this vine! Native Texas reseeding vine.
Pink Jasmine <i>Jasminium polyanthum</i>	Fast growing, to 20 feet. Fragrant clusters of delicate pink flowers with white centers.
Mexican Flame Vine <i>Senecio confusus</i>	Brilliant orange, daisy-like flowers, 1½" -2" across, during the fall. This small vine loves the heat! Zone 10

Akebia 'Shiro Bana' <i>Akebia quinata</i>	Blue-green foliage on twining vine with hanging fragrant flowers. Edible purple fruit. Semi-evergreen in warm climate. Zone 5
Akebia, 'White Chocolate' <i>akebia quinata alba</i>	A white-flowering variety of the popular chocolate vine, this semi-evergreen vine grows rapidly, and has been known to reach heights of 30 feet. Foliage has a lovely
Porcelain Vine (Variegated) <i>Amelopsis</i>	Deciduous vine, that gets blue and white berries. Great climber for morning sun afternoon shade. Attracts butterflies and birds. Does like a mildly acidic soil.
Coral Vine 'Queen's Wreath' <i>Antigonon leptopus</i>	Heat lover! Produces massive sprays of small, bright pink flowers. Pest resistant and soil tolerant. Deciduous.
Crossvine 'Dragon Lady' <i>Bignonia capreolata</i>	Dark-red trumpet shaped blooms on a fast growing, vigorous vine. Self-clinging, quickly covers fences, trellis, and arbors. Zone 7.
Crossvine 'Tangerine Beauty' <i>Bignonia capreolata</i>	Tangerine-ruby flowers in spring and summer. Semi-evergreen, deciduous, rapidly growing vine. Zone 8
Cross Vine <i>Bignonia capreolata</i>	Fast grower to 40'. Semi-evergreen, orange-red trumpet shaped flowers. Zone 6.
Cross Vine, Red <i>Bignonia capreolata var. atrosanqui</i>	Fast growing, self clinging, semi-evergreen vine. Solid red-orange flowers and attractive foliage. Zone 6
Trumpet Vine, 'Morning Calm' <i>Campsis grandiflora</i>	Clusters of peach colored trumpet shaped flowers with yellow throats and pink veins. Blooms July-August.
Yellow Trumpet Vine 'Flava' <i>Campsis radicans</i>	Vigorous grower to 30 feet. Compound, lustrous green leaves and bright yellow tubular flowers. Deciduous. Zone 5
Trumpet Vine <i>Campsis radicans</i>	Vigorous grower to 30'. Compound, lustrous green leaves and bright yellow tubular flowers. Deciduous. Zone 5
Trumpet Vine, 'Minnesota Red' <i>Campsis radicans</i>	Clusters of dark red-orange, trumpet shaped flowers. Full sun for maximum growth and flower production. Drought tolerant once est.
Trumpet Vine, 'Summer Snowfall' <i>Campsis radicans 'Takarazuka'</i>	Intense white variegation splashed on green leaves. Striking orange trumpet shaped flowers bloom all summer.
Trumpet Vine 'Madame Galen' <i>Campsis x tagliabuana</i>	Deciduous vine with compound leaves bearing profuse, red-orange trumpet shaped flowers. A quick summer screen. Full sun. Zone 5
Evergreen Clematis <i>Clematis armandii</i>	Evergreen to semi-evergreen vine with dark green leathery foliage. Very fragrant, star-like white clusters blooms early spring. Zone 7

Clematis, Jackman <i>Clematis jackmanii</i>	Old reliable dark purple variety, one of the best performers in North Texas. This award-winning variety is a favorite of many gardeners due to its heavy blooming &
Clematis, Sweet Autumn <i>Clematis paniculata</i>	Extremely fragrant, vigorous vine with profuse clusters of small white blooms. Will grow large in one season, and huge the next. Cutting it to the ground in spring will
Clematis <i>Clematis x hybrida</i>	Many colors. See a Garden Advisor for details.
Creeping Fig <i>Ficus pumila</i>	Vigorous, close clinging branches 25'-30', adheres to any surface. 2" leaves are leathery and dark green. Evergreen. Zone 9
Carolina Jessamine <i>Gelsemium sempervirens</i>	Shrubby and twining with fragrant yellow blooms in early spring. Evergreen. Zone 6
Primrose Jasmine <i>Jasminium mesnyi</i>	Semi-evergreen shrub with 1" yellow flowers in spring. Arching growth habit. Zone 8
Winter Jasmine <i>Jasminum nudiflorum</i>	Deciduous, slender, arching shrub with small dark green leaves that appear after the yellow blooms. This jasmine has no scent. Train on a trellis or grow as a shrubby
Honeysuckle, 'Mandarin' <i>Lonicera</i>	Mandarin orange-red tubular flowers with pale orange throats, will attract lots of hummingbirds to your garden.
Honeysuckle 'Pink Lemonade' <i>Lonicera heckrottii</i>	Very prolific bloomer with fragrant coral-pink tubular flowers. Deciduous, non-invasive vine. Zone 4
Honeysuckle, 'Graham Thomas' <i>Lonicera periclymenum</i>	Continuous display of white scented flowers turning a creamy yellow as they mature.
Coral Honeysuckle <i>Lonicera sempervirens</i>	Deciduous shrub with vine-like habit to 15'. Coral flowers. Zone 4.
Honeysuckle 'Dropmore Scarlet' <i>Lonicera x brownii</i>	An improved form of Coral Honeysuckle, more hardy and better blooming.
Honeysuckle 'Goldflame' <i>Lonicera x heckrottii</i>	A scarcely climbing, spreading deciduous shrub. Dark green leaves and beautiful yellow and pink flowers. Zone 5
Butterfly Vine <i>Mascagnia macroptera</i>	
Evergreen Wisteria <i>Millettia reticulata</i>	Woody semi-evergreen twining vine. Deep wine, pea shaped-flowers. Zones 8-10.
Wisteria, Evergreen <i>millettia reticulata</i>	Woody semi-evergreen twining vine. Deep wine colored, sweet pea shaped flowers. Zones 8-10.
Virginia Creeper 'Star Showers' <i>Parthenocissus quinquefolia</i>	Unique, "paint-splatter" white markings on green foliage. Has pinkish cast in cool weather. Deciduous. Zone 4.
Virginia Creeper <i>Parthenocissus quinquefolia</i>	Well-loved vigorous vine. Excellent for covering large areas. Brilliant red fall color and purple berries. Deciduous. Full sun. Zone 4
Boston Ivy 'Vietchii' <i>Parthenocissus tricuspidata</i>	Small, maple-like leaves are dark purple when young. Has a close clinging growth habit and scarlet fall color. Deciduous. Zone 5
Dwarf Boston Ivy 'Lowii' <i>Parthenocissus tricuspidata</i>	Vigorous, deciduous vine with smaller leaves than other species. Green foliage is tinged purple with metallic blue berries. Zone 5.
Passion Vine 'Constance Elliot' <i>Passiflora caerulea</i>	Pure white blooms all summer.
Passion Vine 'Incense' <i>Passiflora incarnata</i>	Root hardy to 5 degrees. Very showy, fragrant flowers.
Passion Flower Vine <i>Passiflora incarnata</i>	[see Passion Flower list for complete listing]
Silver Lace Vine <i>Polygonum aubertii</i>	Fleecy clusters of tiny greenish white, fragrant flowers in late spring and again in fall. Deciduous.
White Lady Banks Rose 'Alba ple <i>Rosa banksiae var. Alba plena</i>	Semi-evergreen climber to 20 feet. Profusion of double, white, 1" flowers. Great for fences and banks. Zone 6
Lady Banks Rose 'Normalis lutea' <i>Rosa banksiae var. luteas</i>	Semi-evergreen climber to 20'. Profusion of canary yellow double blooms. Great fence and bank planting. Zone 6
Madison Jasmine <i>Trachelospermum jasminoides</i>	More hardy than Confederate jasmine. Needs help to climb. Can be used as ground cover.

Confederate Jasmine 'Madison' <i>Trachelospermum jasminoides</i>	Hardy form of confederate jasmine that blooms fragrant, white, star shaped flowers. Fully hardy in Dallas, evergreen into the upper teens.
Yellow Jasmine "Mandianum" <i>Trachelospermum jasminoides 'Man</i>	
Jasmine 'Mandy' <i>Trachelospermum x asiaticum</i>	Similar to Confederate jasmine, but with smaller leaves and yellowish white flowers and a slightly different fragrance. More hardy. Evergreen to the mid-teens, root
Wisteria 'Amethyst' <i>Wisteria floribunda</i>	Deep-purple, fragrant clusters of flowers in the spring. Woody, twining habit that likes full sun. Deciduous. Zone 5
Wisteria 'Beni Fu' <i>Wisteria floribunda</i>	Vigorous twining vine with racemes of fragrant pink flowers.
Japanese Wisteria 'Macrobotrys' <i>Wisteria floribunda</i>	Vigorous twining vine with unusually long racemes of highly fragrant flowers
Wisteria 'Snow Showers' <i>Wisteria floribunda</i>	Deciduous vine growing to 20 feet. Clusters of 2" long white flowers in early spring.
Texas Purple <i>Wisteria floribunda</i>	Deciduous vine with vigorous twining stems. Best when trained on an arbor, trellis or fence to the spectacular pendulous violet flower clusters.
Kentucky Wisteria 'Clara Mack' <i>Wisteria macrostachys</i>	Vigorous, climbing vine with clusters of slightly fragrant white flowers.
White Wisteria 'Alba' <i>Wisteria sinensis</i>	Slightly fragrant grape-like clusters of white flowers in spring. Woody, twining habit that likes full sun. Deciduous. Zone 5
Wisteria <i>Wisteria sinensis</i>	Showy, slightly fragrant, large violet-blue grape-like clusters. Woody, twining habit that likes full sun. Deciduous. Zone 5
Wisteria 'Caroline' <i>Wisteria x hybrida</i>	Grape-like clusters of lavender-pink flowers appear in spring. Woody, twining habit that likes full sun. Deciduous. Zone 5

## Tropical

Yellow Allamanda 'Hendersonii' <i>Allamanda cathartica</i>	Six inch glossy green foliage with large, yellow trumpet shape flowers. Hardy to 32 F.
Climbing Hydrangea <i>Hydrangea petiolaris</i>	Vigorous climber with dark green heart-shaped leaves that need strong supports for climbing. Has lovely cinnamon colored exfoliating bark. Very pretty white, flat
Mandevilla 'Little Red Riding Hoo' <i>Mandevilla sanderi</i>	Compact, shrubby habit with continuous cherry-pink blooms all summer. Zone 10
Mandevilla 'Alice du Pont' <i>Mandevilla x amabilis</i>	Large, showy trumpet shaped flowers all summer long. Zone 10
Rangoon Creeper <i>Quis qualis</i>	Freely branching tropical climber. Fragrant, red to pink ½" to ¾" tubular flowers. Bright green 3" foliage. Root hardy in mild winters.
Potato Vine <i>Solanum jasminoides</i>	Star shaped white flowers are accented by a cluster of yellow stamens in the center. A vigorous grower to 5'. 50 F. Zone 9
St. Vincent Lilac <i>Solanum seaforthianum</i>	Perfect small garden or container vine. Clusters of light blue, star-shaped flowers are followed by bright red pea sized fruit. Zone 9
Blue Sky Vine <i>Thunbergia grandiflora</i>	Large 3" lavender flowers, trumpet shaped on a vigorous vine that is resistant to insects and diseases. Hardy to 32° F.
