American Beauty !	Pink	1875. Hybrid Perpetual. Strong tea-scented blooms. Blooms heaviest in spring and fall. Thornless.
Buff Beauty !	Apricot	1939. Hybrid Musk. Nearly continuous bloomer with double blooms and a sweet scent.
CL Cecile Brunner !	Pink	1894. Polyantha Climber. Clusters of small pointed pastel pink buds open to reveal creamy pink blooms with a moderate tea fragrances. Blooms heaviest in spring on old wood, some reblooming in the fall.
CL Lady Banks White !	White	1807. Species. Long-lived species rose. Covered with small blooms in spring. Thornless climber & very fragrant. Rosa banksiae alba.
CL Lady Banks Yellow !	Yellow	1824. Species. Fragrant double flowers bloom in spring. Thornless climber. Rosa banksiae lutea.
CL Peggy Martin !	Pink	UNK. Climber. Famous rose that survived Hurricane Katrina. Blooms throughout the growing season.
CL Souvenir de la Malmaison !	Pink	1893. Bourbon Climber - Large pale pink blooms, sport of 'Souvenir de la Malmaison'. Repeat bloomer, very fragrant.
CL Zepherine Drouhin !	Cerise Pink	1868. Thornless climber that blooms a beautiful cerise-pink in spring and fall with a strong bourbon fragrance.
Cramoisi Superieur !	Crimson	1832. China. Low-growing shrub with clusters of blooms all summer. Sweet, fruity fragrance.
Dame De Coeur !	Crimson	1958. Early Hybrid Tea. Large, double blooms darken with age. Excellent for cutting.
Highway 290 Pink Buttons !	Pink	UNK. Found Rose. Small rosy pink blossoms on a compact form. Repeat bloomer.
Le Vesuve !	Pink	1825. China. Large lilac-pink blooms with wonderfully swirled centers. Blooms almost nonstop during the growing season. Fragrant.
Maggie !	Violet	UNK. Shrub. A found rose with highly fragrant flowers, blooms through summer and has rose hips in fall.
Marchessa Boccella !	Pink	1842. Hybrid Perpetual. Clusters of delicate, pink, multi-petaled blooms sit atop jade green foliage. True to it's classification, this rose seems to be in perpetual bloom. Intense rose fragrance.
Marie Pavie !	Cream	1888. Polyantha - Nearly thornless rose. Musk fragrance. Pink buds open to clusters of creamy white blooms.
Martha Gonzales !	Scarlet	1984. China. A found rose that is a continuous show of single petal blooms. Disease resistant.
Mermaid !	Yellow	1918. Climber. Fragrant, large, single flowers. Repeats best once established.
Nacogdoches !	Yellow	UNK. Found rose believed to be in the Floribunda class. Eye-catching, bright yellow pointed blooms are great for cutting. Also called 'Grandma's Yellow'. Reblooming and fragrant.
Paul Neyron !	Pink	1869. Hybrid Perpetual. Fragrant rich pink flowers can reach up to 6 or 7 inches wide. Can be trained as a climber.
Sombreuil !	White	1850. Tea. Creamy-white blooms are very large, flat, and quartered, with a most delicious tea rose fragrance. This mannerly climber is ideally suited for use as a pillar rose, or training on a low wall, fence, or trellis.

Abraham Darby	Apricot	Large, cup-shaped blooms in shades of apricot, yellow and pink. A repeat bloomer with a rich, fruity fragrance.
Benjamin Britten	Reddish Pink	The unique shade of deep red-pink makes this rose glow in the landscape. Large rosette-shaped blooms with an intense fruity fragrance. May be trained as a climber.
Carding Mill	Apricot	Large blooms in shades of pink, apricot and yellow. Strong, beautiful myrrh fragrance. Repeats well. Enjoys warmer climates.
Charlotte	Yellow	Sumptuous soft yellow, cup-shaped blooms with a delicious tea rose fragrance. Excellent repeat flowering and good disease resistance.
Claire Austin *	White	Pale lemon-yellow buds open to reveal large, multi-petaled blooms. Grown as an arching shrub or climber. Complex myrrh and vanilla fragrance.

Darcey Bussell *	Crimson	Deep crimson rosettes with a delightful fruity fragrance. An exceptional variety which flowers freely and repeats well. Compact, bushy growth.
Gertrude Jekyll	Pink	Large rosettes of rich, glowing pink. Strong well-balanced old rose fragrance. Maybe trained as a climber. Repeat flowering.
Golden Celebration	Gold	Large golden blooms have a strong tea fragrance with a hint of strawberry. Forms a rounded, arching shrub or may be used as a climber. Repeat flowering.
Graham Thomas !	Yellow	Rich yellow cup-shaped blooms with a strong, fresh tea fragrance. Voted the World's Favorite Rose by the World Federation of Rose Societies. May be grown as a large shrub or trained as a climber. Repeat flowering.
Lady Emma Hamilton *	Tangerine	Ruby-red buds open to reveal double, cupped flowers of tangerine-orange blooms. Intense fruity fragrance with hints of pear, grape and citrus. Forms an upright, bushy shrub that is a repeat bloomer.
Lady of Shalott *	Apricot	Striking apricot-yellow, chalice-shaped blooms. Healthy with vigorous, bushy growth. Ideal for inexperienced gardeners. Mild tea fragrance with hints of apples and cloves. Repeat flowering with good disease resistance.
Lichfield Angel * !	Cream	Vigorous rounded shrub with apricot buds, that open to reveal creamy white, dome-shaped blooms. Light, spicy scent. Repeat flowering.
Molineux *	Yellow	Rich yellow, rosette-shaped flowers with a musky, tea rose fragrance. Upright growth habit and exceptional blooming. Repeat flowering. Winner of three awards.
Munstead Wood *	Crimson	Light crimson buds open to reveal large cup-shaped blooms with velvety, deep crimson centers. Strong old rose fragrance with unertones of blackberry and blueberry. Named after Gertrude Jekyll's garden in Surrey.
Olivia Rose Austin !	Pale Pink	A lovely soft shade of pink with a strong, pleasing, fruity fragrance. The growth is vigorous and it repeat-flowers well. One of the most disease-resistant varieties of English roses.
Princess Alexandra of Kent *	Pink	Flowers are full-petaled and deeply cupped. The center of the bloom is a glowing pink ringed by outer petals of pale pink. Delicious tea fragrance with hints of lemon and black currant as the blooms age. Repeat flowering.
Scepter'd Isle' *	Pink	Soft pink blooms open to reveal clusters of golden stamens. Lovely 'English Rose' myrrh scent. Repeat flowering.
Teasing Georgia !	Yellow	Beautifully formed golden yellow blooms with a lovely, strong tea fragrance. An easy to grow selection for your rose garden. Shows good disease resistance and repeat flowering.
The Ancient Mariner !	Pink	An impressive variety, bearing masses of very large pink blooms. Old world tea fragrance, repeat bloomer almost continually from June until the first frosts.
The Generous Gardener	Pale Pink	Delicate, cup-shaped, pale pink blooms. Strong old rose, musk and myrrh scent. Repeat flowering.
The Lady Gardener	Apricot	Large, full petalled, rich apricot blooms. Strong and delicious tea fragrance. Repeat flowers quickly.
The Wedgewood Rose *	Soft Pink	The charming old rose blooms are a delicate soft pink with a fruity fragrance on the outer petals and a clove scented center. Repeat flowering and may be trained as a climber.
Windermere *	Cream	Perfectly rounded buds, open to full, cupped flowers that are rich cream at first, fading to almost pure white in the sun. Fragrant fruity essence with grapefruit overtones. Repeat flowering with good disease resistance.
Wollerton Old Hall	Pale Apricot	Beautiful, very rounded flowers of soft apricot fading to cream. One of the most fragrant roses with a distinctive myrrh scent. Repeat flowering.

Colette	Pink	Old fashioned, damask scented blooms adorn this climber. Blooms on old and new wood.
Don Juan	Red	Favored by rosarians and gardeners alike for more than half a century. Dark, red, fragrant flowers will cover this rose once established. Blooms on old and new wood.
Highwire Flyer !	Hot Pink	New for 2018. Strong, vibrant hot pink, blooms on a bushy climber. Repeat blooming.
Iceberg	White	An excellent climbing rose with sprays of medium-sized, white flowers that exude a mild honey fragrance. Good repeat flowering, blooms on old wood only.
Joseph's Coat	Yellow/Red	Colorful blooms of yellow & scarlet. Good repeat bloom. Blooms on old & new wood.
Lady in Red	Dark Red	New for 2018. The old fashioned, double ruffled blooms are dark red suffused with an occasional black smoke. Light tea fragrance.
Pearly Gates *	Pearl Pink	Large, full, pearl pink blooms with a strong spice and rose scent. Free flowering, blooms on old and new wood.
Red Cascade !	Red	Climber. Profuse bloomer covered in one-inch red flowers.
Sky's the Limit *	Yellow	Clusters of buttery-yellow blooms on a free flowering climber, with a light fruity fragrance. Reblooming even in the first season.
Tropical Lightning	Orange/Cream	Clusters of sunset-like orange blooms with a creamy white stripe that hold their color for days after opening. Moderate fruity, apple-like fragrance.

White Dawn	White	Clusters of white, ruffled blooms on a vigorous plant. Sweet rose fragrance. Blooms on old and new wood.

Belinda's Dream !	Pink	First rose to be named Texas Superstar and receive prestigious Earth Kind designation. Very disease resistant shrub, large fragrant pink double blooms.
Caldwell Pink !	Pink	UNK. Polyantha. Everblooming found rose named after it's location in Caldwell, Texas. The double, lilac-pink flowers form clusters that can be seen at a distance. Nice compact growth habit.
Carefree Beauty !	Pink	This vigorous, upright shrub rose sports smooth, olive-green leaves and clusters of cup-shaped, semi-double, fragrant, bubble-gum pink flowers from spring to fall. Also known as 'Katy Road Pink'. A Griffith Buck introduction.
CL New Dawn !	Pink	Climbing. Hardy and vigorous. Large, fragrant pale pink flowers that bloom on old and new wood.
Climbing Pinkie !	Rose	Polyantha Climber. Rose pink, cupped shaped blooms are produced in clusters with great profusion. The nearly thornless canes are easy to work with when training it as a climber. Fragrant and reblooming.
Ducher !	White	1869. China. The only white China. The buds are very round and sometimes have a hint of pink on the outer petals opening to a delicate swirl of fragrant ivory petals. Smaller than many Chinas, this is a good candidate for a container.
Duchesse de Brabant !	Pink	1857 Tea. Very fragrant cupped, pink blooms. Good repeat flowering with some hips to follow in the fall.
Knock Out !	Red	Introduced in 2000 and hailed a "breakthrough shrub rose" for its disease resistance and hardiness. Single cherry red flowers bloom throughout the growing season. TEXAS SUPERSTAR
La Marne !	Pink	1915. Polyantha. Erect growth habit that can be maintained at any size. The open flowers are borne in loose clusters of pink and white.
Marie Daly !	Pink	Polyantha. A sport of 'Marie Pavie' with clusters of medium pink, double flowers all season long. Fragrant, repeat blooming and almost thornless.
Mme. Antoine Mari !	Pink	1901. Tea. Fragrant flowers that fade to cream. Blooms almost non-stop. Full rounded growth habit.
Mrs. Dudley Cross	Yellow/Pink Blus	1907. Shrub. A compact, shapely bush with a constant supply of fragrant, double, delicately shaped yellow flowers that blush a little pink in the sun. The stems are nearly always thornless.
Mutabilis !	Yellow & Red	Prior to 1894. China. All season bloom. Colors change from yellow to orange to red and finally crimson. Also known as the "Butterfly rose."
Sea Foam !	Cream	Can be considered a climber or a Rambler. Double, creamy-white flowers look lovely in an all white garden. Reblooming and slightly fragrant.
The Fairy !	Pink	Shrub. Profuse clusters of small, double, pink flowers. Very profuse bloom habit, repeats well.

Apricot Drift * !	Apricot	Double apricot flowers bloom spring through fall. Best for small gardens or along pathways.
Coral Drift * !	Coral	The most rounded of the Drift series. Covered in small, semi double coral blooms.
Peach Drift * !	Peach	Pretty peach blooms on a rounded form.
Pink Drift * !	Pink	Low-growing shrub with a 3' spread. Deep pink flowers bloom throughout the season.
Popcorn Drift * !	Cream	Yellow buds fade to creamy blooms, leaving the impression of buttered popcorn.
Rainbow Happy Trails * !	Yellow/Pink	A true groundcover rose that blooms throughout the season. Golden yellow blooms are blushed with pink and seem to sparkle in the sun.
Red Drift * !	Red	Almost a true red bloom. Excellent used in small gardens or large containers.
Sunshine Happy Trails * !	Gold	An excellent groundcover rose with buttery golden blooms. Slight fruity fragrance.
Sweet Drift * !	Pink	Double blooms on mounding shrub. Best suited for small gardens, borders or along pathways.
White Drift * !	White	The newest addition to the Drift Series of roses. It has beautiful bright white, fully double blooms along with a true ground cover habit.

Easy Going *	Apricot/Yellow	Large glowing blooms of golden apricot-yellow with a light fruity fragrance. Good disease resistance and repeat flowering.
Easy Spirit	White	New for 2018. Perfectly shaped cream colored buds open to reveal a classic white rose. The 3-4 inch blooms have a mild tea fragrance. Upright growth habit with glossy green foliage. Reblooming.
Ebb Tide *	Purple	Dusky, deep-purple buds open to very double flowers of velvety plum. Strong clove fragrance.
Fired Up * !	Yellow/Orange	Unique and striking color best described as yellow and bright orange striped, finishing blood orange. Color does not fade in the heat or when finishing and reblooms well.
Frida Kahlo	Red/Gold	New for 2018. Blooms are set in small clusters of 3-4 inch flowers. Each blossom is a unique blend of rosy-red and gold stripes with a red blush over all.
George Burns *	Yellow/Red	Multi-colored yellow, pink, red and cream. Large, citrus-scented ruffled blooms.
Hot Cocoa *	Orange	AARS 2003 Winner. Unique, fragrant smoky orange flowers on an upright shrub.
Iceberg !	White	Large, double fragrant flowers with profuse blooms on a medium bush. Makes a good hedge.
Julia Child * !	Gold	AARS 2006 Winner. Butter gold color & licorice candy fragrance on a repeat blooming rose.
Lava Flow	Dark Red	Deep, velvety, red ruffled flowers, on a compact growing plant.
Livin' Easy * !	Apricot	AARS 1996 Winner. Loads of bright and bold orange, semi-double 3 1/2" blooms that have a clove/spicy fragrance are borne on a repeat blooming plant.
Passionate Kisses !	Salmon	Unusual salmon colored roses bloom on a tidy shrub. Good for cutting.
Rosie the Riveter	Ornge Blend	New for 2018. Unusual flowers of orange-gold suffused with pink have a moderately fruity scent with spicy undertones.
Shockwave *	Yellow	The glossy, apple-green foliage makes a great backdrop for the glowing, yellow blooms. A consistent repeat bloomer.
Sparkle and Shine * !	Yellow	Clusters of bright yellow fade resistant blooms on a rounded bushy plant. Repeat blooming with a light fruit fragrance.
Trumpter !	Red Orange	Long lasting red-orange, ruffled blossoms stand out against glossy green foliage. Good disease resistance and a great rose to use in mass plantings.
Violet's Pride	Lavender	'Downton Abbey' Collection. Named after Lady Violet, the Dowager Countess of Grantham this rose bears clusters of medium-large, 3½-4 inch diameter blooms with a spicy citrus fragrance.

'Dream Come True' *	Yellow & Red	2008 AARS Winner. Golden yellow edged in ruby red.
Gold Medal	Gold	Shapely dark gold buds are brushed with orange and open to deep golden yellow. The long stems are low-thorned with deep green foliage. The fragrance has a hint of spice and fruit.

Moonstone *	White/Pink	Ivory white flowers with a fine, delicate pink edging. Mild, spice, tea fragrance. Large, double, mostly solitary blooms. Blooms in flushes throughout the season.
New Zealand *	Pink	Strong honeysuckle fragrance on a disease resistant plant.
Peace	Yellow/Pink	AARS 1946 Winner. Huge, opulent blooms in a delicious blend of pastel pink and yellow with a mild fruity fragrance.
Perfume Delight	Rose Pink	Deep rose-pink buds open into large, fully double 5" blooms, which are borne on long stems for cutting. The perfume is strong, heady old damask rose fragrance. Good continual re-bloomer.
Pink Traviata *	Deep Pink	True quartered, old fashioned blooms in a beautiful deep pink.
Pope John Paul II *	White	Radiant white rose named for Pope John Paul II. J&P Rose for a Cause.
Pretty Lady Rose	Rose	'Downton Abbey' Collection. 'Pretty Lady Rose' has deep rose colored blooms with a sweet, spicy fragrance. The perfect match to the character that this rose is named after.
Princess Charlene de Monaco *	Shell Pink	Very fragrant fully double flowers that are a light apricot to shell pink in color.
Rio Samba	Yellow/Orange	AARS 1993 Winner. Bright, golden-yellow blooms that blush to orange.
Rouge Royale *	Burgundy	Fully quartered blooms. Sweet fragrance of citrus and berries.
Sedona *	Coral Blend	Blooms in shades of coral, orange and red that are reminiscent of the high desert sunset. Unique pear fragrance.
St. Patrick *	Gold	Unusual green tint highlights the golden blooms. AARS 1996 Winner.
Sugar Moon *	White	Classically formed pristine white blooms that exude an intense citrus and rose fragrance. The green-black foliage makes the white blossoms stand out. A must have for the cutting garden.

Pioneer Spirit !	Pink	Mimics the old Tea, 'Sombreuil', in flower and form except that it is pink. The 6 to 8 feet long canes hold shiny foliage and lightly fragrant, full medium pink roses. Can be trained as a climber.
Rita Dennis !	Red	The growth habit of 'Rita Dennis' is like that of a classic Hybrid Tea, but much more carefree. The fragrant, double dark red roses have petals that are ruffled and frilly. Fragrant and re-blooming.
Star of the Republic !	Apricot	"The best" of the Texas Pioneer roses introduced by Mike Shoup. It is truly exceptional! The fragrant, quartered blooms of peachy-apricot appear in late spring and are followed by a strong fall repeat.
Sweet Pea !	Mauve	A seedling of 'Lavender Pink Parfait'. The one inch blooms of lavender and mauve are accentuated by the bright yellow stamens. Fragrant and reblooming.

Antique Roses

These Old Garden roses are naturally disease resistant, hardier and require less care than most other roses. Garden roses are generally very fragrant and adaptable to a variety of landscape situations. They have many classifications ranging from dwarfs to cluster blooms to climbers and everything in between.

David Austin English Roses

These roses bring the romance and charm of the roses of years past to your garden. Their blooms are packed with layers of petals, appealing fragrances and soft coloring.

Climbing Roses

Many of our modern rose climbers originated from hybrid teas that have a tendency to grow unusually long canes. Climbers can grow to a length of 18 to 20 feet and bloom as profusely as many hybrid teas. Unlike other types of roses, climbers are not pruned heavily each spring. They should be selectively pruned after the first flush of blooms.

Florascap Roses

These hardy spreading roses quickly cover large areas creating a carpet of low maintenance color ideal for slopes and rocky areas. Great in baskets for trailing color.

Floribunda Roses

This type of rose began as a cross between Polyantha and hybrid tea. The cross was such a success that an entire new call of rose was named. These shrubs reach 2 ½ to 3 ½ feet in height, with dense branching. They are free blooming with small blooms in large clusters.

Grandiflora Roses

Queen Elizabeth, when it was introduced in 1955, was clearly an extraordinary rose. However, it did not fit any of the already existing classifications. It was, therefore, given the distinction of naming a rose category for it. This type usually ranges from 4 ½ feet upward with long stems sometimes supporting several blooms, but slightly smaller than hybrid tea. Most Grandiflora shrubs support a heavy compliment of blooms throughout the growing season and are an excellent source of flowers.

Hybrid Tea Roses

This is the best type for cut flowers since each stem has only one bloom. Bushes grow 3 ½ to 4 ½ feet tall and get bigger in ideal conditions. The Hybrid Tea is the most popular type of rose sold in America.

Miniature Roses

These roses are small in stature but are prolific bloomers. They generally do not exceed 2 feet tall and bloom continuously with small flowers. They are extremely low maintenance and are great for containers.

Shrub/Hedge Roses

These roses are easy-care, versatile and fragrant. They adapt well to many soils and temperatures. They have colorful hips throughout winter.

Texas Pioneer Roses

These roses are the result of crosses between some of Dr. Robert Basye's disease resistant varieties and David Austin's English Roses, Hybrid Perpetuals, Hybrid Teas and other large-flowering shrub roses. The roses are named for various people and places important to Texas heritage. You will find them to be beautiful, resilient and tough, much like the early Texas pioneers they honor.
