A super easy crop that packs a punch of nutrition. Start **kale** in fall and grow successive crops through early winter and spring. Broccoli, **cauliflower** and Brussels sprouts thrive in the cooler months as well.



Chop the leaves as well as the stems of **Swiss chard** in a quick sauté with salt and pepper for a delicious, healthy treat.



Purple pak choi is a tasty Chinese cabbage that's so lovely it can also be used ornamentally.

Did you know you can cook with **pumpkin**? Bake and scoop out the flesh for soups, pie and even smoothies. Don't forget the nutritious seeds!

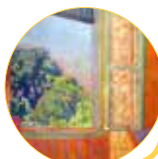
